The unit also covers the process of lesson planning in the TESOL context, including the components of a lesson plan, and how and why certain techniques are employed based on knowledge of teaching and learning theories.</p>

	<p>This unit describes the outcomes required to demonstrate the ability to teach English to teenagers both in Australia and overseas.</p> <p>This unit focuses on preparing TESOL teachers to teach adolescents in the TESOL context. The unit covers key features of adolescents that affect learning English.</p>
